Submission Guidelines for Neisseria gonorrhoeae Gradient Strip AST



All test requests require preauthorization before specimen submission <u>ARLNutah@utah.gov</u>

1. Isolate/Specimen labeling Requirements

- a. Isolate/prepared specimen must be clearly labeled
- b. A minimum of two unique patient identifiers. Acceptable identifiers include:
 - i. Patient's full name
 - ii. Date of birth
 - iii. Medical record number
 - iv. Last 4 digits of social security number
- c. Date of specimen collection
- d. Unlabeled specimens received by UPHL will be rejected

2. Shipping Requirements

- a. Once the specimen has been approved by ARLNutah@utah.gov for shipment, the patient specimen should be prepared according to the criteria below:
 - i. Sending a frozen sample in 10-20 % glycerol for identification, ship using an insulated cooler with dry ice.
 - ii. If sending a slant or plate (MTM, chocolate agar), fresh subculture less than 24 hours old, ship at ambient temperature.
 - iii. The isolate/specimen should be shipped following the International Air Transportation Association's (IATA) Category B regulations
- b. Include a completed copy of the Utah ARLN GC ETest test request form.

3. Shipping information

- a. Isolates/specimens should be shipped overnight Monday-Thursday to the following address by FedEx or for Utah patients by courier.
